




The pictured acute care renovation of an existing operating room was undertaken to accommodate a hybrid biplane that facilitates neuro- and cardiacspecific procedures. Located in the heart of a fully active and occupied operating suite, infection control was of tantamount importance. It was essential that construction be completed without shutting down the surrounding operating rooms and associated support spaces. The site was accessed via the mechanical mezzanine, minimizing the amount of travel through the active surgical suite.

Outpatient

Health and hospitality.

We focus on designing welcoming and holistic spaces for patients, visitors, and staff across a broad range of services, from primary care to diagnostics and ambulatory infusion treatment. We deliver highly collaborative projects and innovative brand standards that balance the efficient work flow of staff with the patient experience.

This Ambulatory Infusion Clinic is designed to maximize daylight and views to create a serene, welcoming, space for both patients and visitors. Along with providing patients with unobstructed outdoor views, the open bay design in this project maximizes staff sightlines from inboard work areas. Utilizing an inclusive design process allowed the client, end users, and vendors to all feel heard and helped lead users to a final design reflected their needs and values as caregivers. The resulting space includes 11 infusion bays, two private infusion rooms, two nurses stations, a waiting area, and associated staff areas that are highly customized while also staying within Swedish brand standards. This culminates in a space that provides positive outcomes for all inhabitants.

The architecture, interior design, and medical planning are woven together, increasing views of nature by centering around deeply cut rooftop ravines and outdoor gardens. A prominent landmark in the community, this building will continue to serve as a beacon for those in need of emergency or ongoing care and treatment.

It is one of only five centers in North America to combine healthcare, pharmaceutical services, retail, and supportive and palliative care housing for people experiencing homelessness.



Blackburn Center provides approximately 3,000 patients per year with access to employment services, housing placement, and complementary clinic services.
